January Gardening Calendar Happy New Closed for Winter Break ... Re-opening on January 9th, 2019! Year! Snow can break limbs on evergreens. Remove heavy snow as needed to prevent damage. Build a snowman whenever you find enough to make it work! Keep your chin up...we'll be planting flowers in the yard soon! Drop by Bookcliff Gardens for a walk through the houseplant room. Mmmm... the scent of warm soil is wonderful! We re-open Thursday, back from Winter Break! Thumb through those seed catalogs again. There are bound to be amazing things in there!
