March Gardening Calendar Plant potted shade & ornamental trees and flowering shrubs as soon as the soil thaws & dries Plant Show West Cut back fern tops of asparagus & add 2" of soil on top of the row. Lightly fertilize & water it in. Saturday & Sunday at Bookcliff Remove dead stems & diseased leaves from perennial beds. Filter Soil Pep between plants in Gardens Plant cool season veggie seeds outdoors now. These include peas, spinach, radishes, carrots, beets and lettuce seeds! What are yours doing? 30 Apply the first treatment of Hi-Yield Permethrin 38% to Pinons to kill Ips Beetles on April 1st. Remove tree wrap from young trees if you haven't already done so. Down & Dirty Greenhouse Tour 11am today Bookcliff Keep an eye on your rose bushes. Prune roses once buds 12" from the soil level have pushed out 1-2".
