Spray Pinyons with Permethrin 38% around July 1st to protect against Ips Beetles.
 Check aspens for signs of borer activity. Spray with Permethrin 38%.
 Find fresh blooming summer perennials and shrubs at Bookcliff Gardens. They're beautiful today!

Apply 3rd drench treatment against tree borers in peach, plum, cherry & apricots on July 10th.
 Deadhead shrub roses as flowers fade. No need to fuss! Hedge shearers work great!
 If your apple & pear trees have fruit, keep treating against codling moth!
 Enjoy summer squash, crispy cucumbers and garden-fresh tomatoes right off the vines! Mmm!!
 Go run through the sprinklers ... even if they're not stuck!

Fertilize veggie gardens once a month with Fertilome Gardener's Choice Vegetable Fertilizer.
 Keep an eye out for insect pests in the yard.

 Water consistently to avoid stressed lawns. Deep, infrequent water creates drought tolerance.
 Check soil moisture to determine schedule. Dig down ... soil should be wet at least 8 inches deep after watering. Water again once your soil has dried to a depth of 4 inches down.

 Beat the heat with a couple brand new shade trees for your backyard!
